 - PVSD Music Department & Youth Arts Academy 2020-21 Update
 - Las Colinas Reese Copsey. No report.
 - Monte Vista Trish Copsey. 1st Quarter at MVS included Intermediate Band, Music 7 Digital Music, and Music 6 General Music with Recorders. 2nd Quarter will include Advanced Band, Beginning Band, and Music 7/8 Digital Music. I am offering 2x week 30-min rehearsals for band classes that aren't meeting as an official class during that particular quarter (e.g. right now I see Advanced Band after school). Once we return to school, I will be offering after school rehearsals for all band students because we are not allowed to have instruments on campus. The after school practices are not required, but strongly recommended so that students can at least maintain their skills during "off" quarters.

We are still working on getting SmartMusic ordered/set up for our band kids. Thanks Betty for continually following up on this! Thank you (SOKM) for the recorders for the 6th grade general music class. The students are enjoying playing music at home.

- K8 by Rene Godina- Beginning and Intermediate Mariachi borrowed instruments last week. PVSEA Beginning Strings have been able to tune instruments. Santa Rosa received instruments last week. Awaiting for Smart Music.
- YAA Strings by Rene Godina- Beginning Strings received instruments last week. Intermediate and Orchestra is a 12 student combo class. All have been playing, awaiting for Smart Music.
- YAA Guitar & Ukulele by Mauricio Giron- with approximately 10 students, all have instruments but no books. Has a website with a supply list and links for stores and lessons. Uses Flip Grid within Google Classroom. There are virtual tests to do on your own. Able to play a game together. Flip Grid can record with instructions from Mauricio. Advanced Guitar practicing G Minor Pentatonic Scale, with 3 different notes over 12 bar blues, whole notes, half and quarter notes and respected rests.
- K-3 Music, YAA Music & Movement, YAA Beg. Piano by Karine Szakos K-3 music in person instruction is on hold with no hard dates set for school

- reopening. Possible 10/26 since Ventura County is in the Red Zone. School will start with Special Education, TK/K, then grades 1-3, 4-5, 6-8, but no specific dates. Still needs to be discussed with teachers and the school board.
